

# Sidegate Lane Landfill - Compost Pad

## Project Particulars

Value: £200,000

Duration: 6 weeks

The Scope of the project involved the design and construction of a composting pad at the existing Sidegate Lane Landfill Site.

Design of this facility was to be submitted to S.I.T.A. UK for approval by Northants County Council, only then could construction commence.

Greyhound Plant Services were solely responsible for developing and managing the contract programme, supervision and preparation of CQA validation reports and also to act as planning supervisor and manage all CDM requirements. At all these stages, close liaison with S.I.T.A UK was essential. Encia supported Greyhound Plant Services throughout the work.



The project consists of a 5,000m<sup>2</sup> tarmacadam bed and lined lagoon of 500m<sup>3</sup> capacity, kerbing and drainage together with a screening bund of 10,000m<sup>3</sup>. A commencement date on site was set for mid April 2003 and completed by the end of May 2004.

Pre planning, design and programming that was carried out in detail prior to commencement ensured the project was completed safely, to specification, on time and within budget.
